Your Brookings Area Habitat for Humanity is nearing 30 years of growing the mission of **Building** Homes and Hope for families in our community. This critical mission has not changed and continues to guide and motivate volunteers, businesses. homeowners and our staff to offer an affordable pathway to home ownership. Currently we are building two homes in Madison and two homes in Brookings and have set a path for a home in Pierre. At the end of 2024, Habitat will have completed 87 homes.

Brookings Area Habitat for Humanity has established partnerships with volunteers in our community from businesses, service organizations, churches, friendship groups, SDSU and retired individuals. Our organization would not have the funding or the ability to construct Habitat homes without everyone's continued dedication and participation.

I recently heard a volunteer say, "I have more time than money." I then heard a donor say, "I have more money than time." Habitat for Humanity can eagerly address both of these situations! Our survival depends on your time, and

our forward momentum is driven by your treasures. We graciously and gratefully ask for both.

As for Time: Our weekly volunteer construction team, "The Foundation Crew," provides families with a consistent, skilled crew. They are always there for us. We encourage you to join this incredible crew of generous people. They give of their time and their talents. They are some of the most critical people who make it possible for people to become homeowners.

As for Treasure: Our donors are our future for addressing the explosive building costs in our region. The increasing cost of building affordable decent homes is a major challenge.

The Habitat ReStore, located on Highway 14, is a significant revenue source for construction costs to build Habitat homes. The ReStore has boosted our exposure in our community and region. The ReStore also exists to divert tons of useful furnishings and excess home remodeling materials from the landfill. Recent gifts include a truck and boat. This, too, is an eye-opening place to volunteer.


